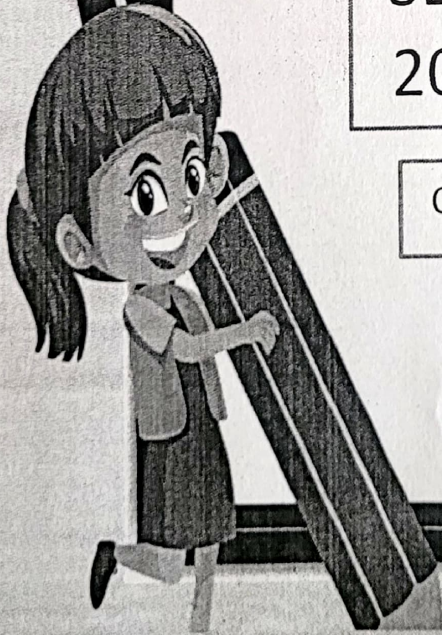



The days are long and warm,



शिक्षा: मेहनत का फल हमेशा मीठा होता है।


3. बुद्धिमान बालक


3. Save Water

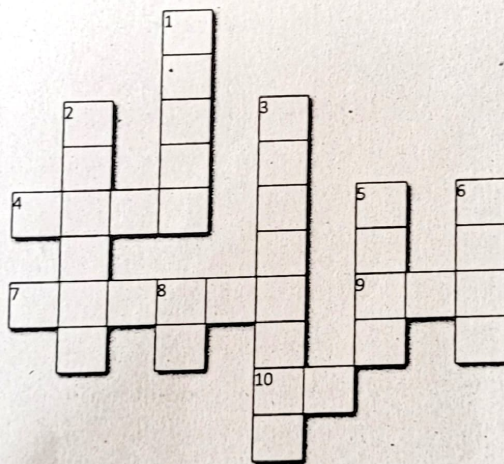
