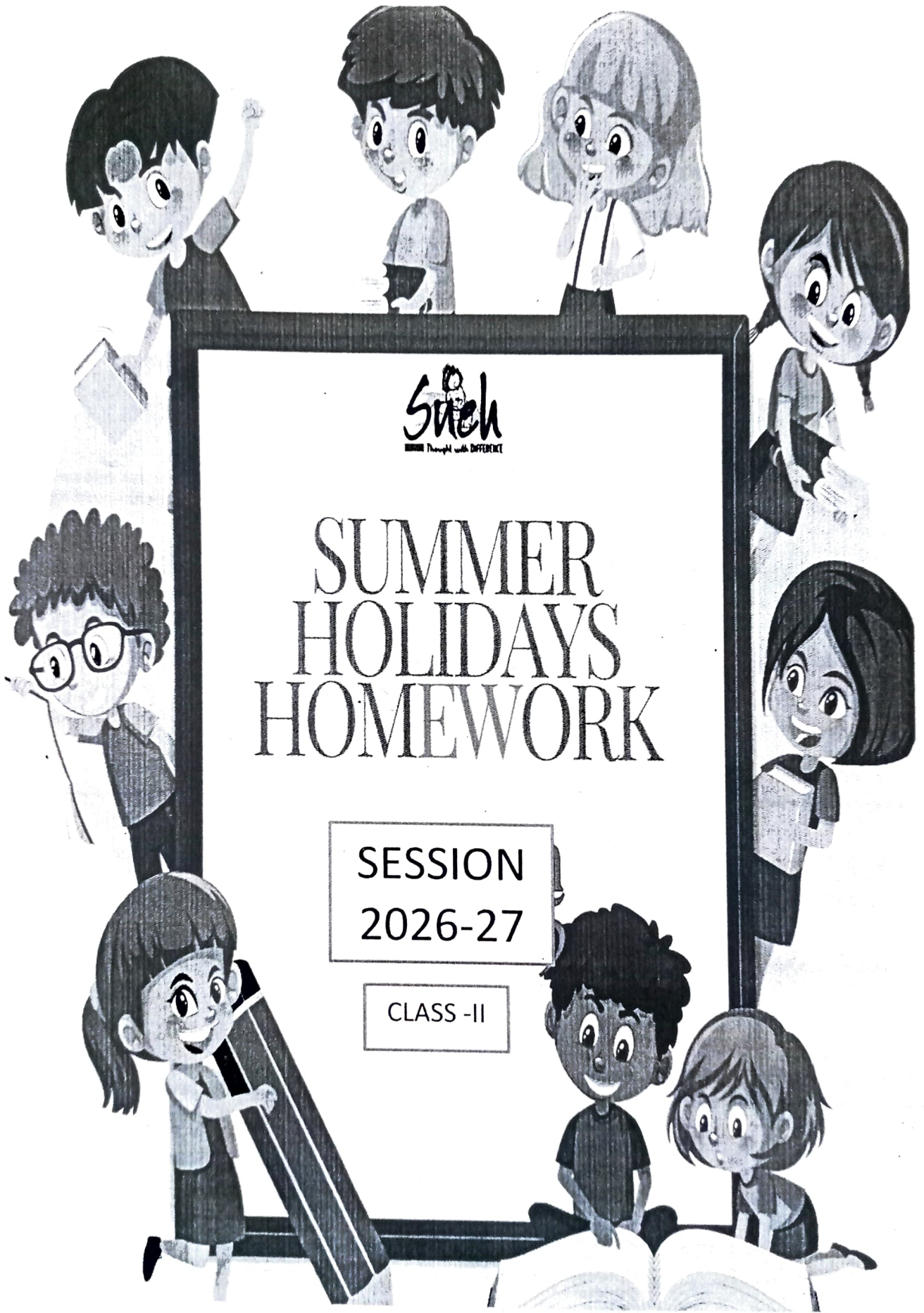


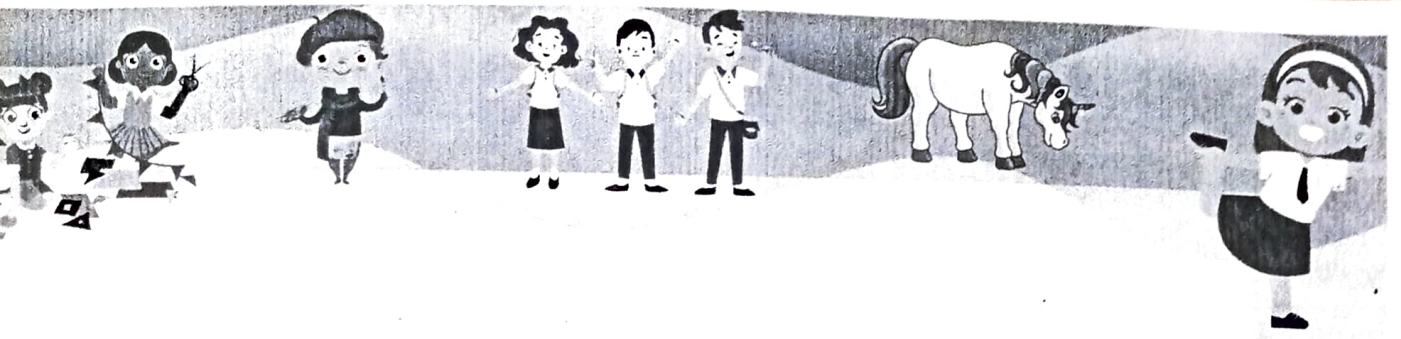

They saw a bear coming.

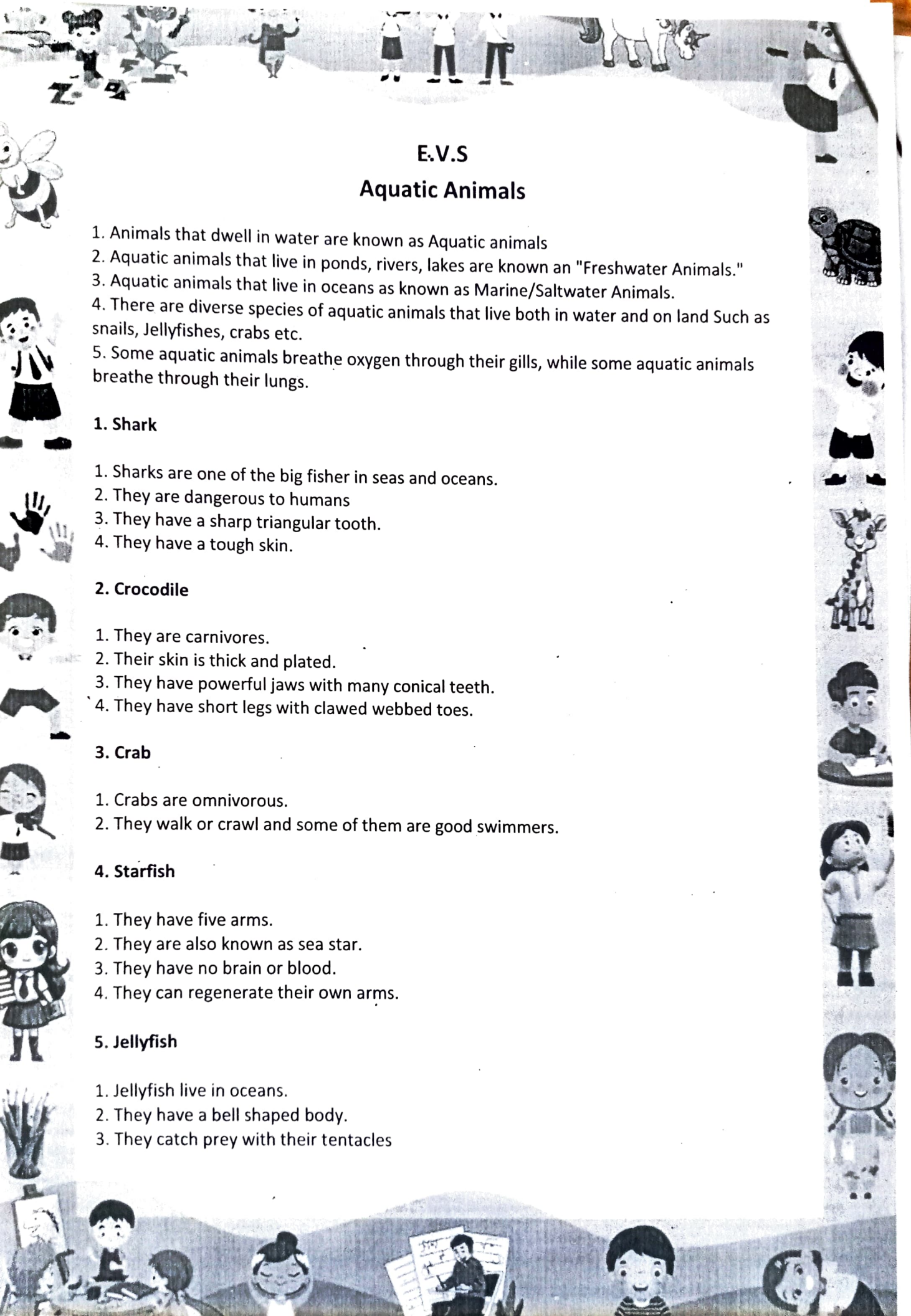
One friend climbed a tree.

 3. Fish are cold blooded.


8. Octopus
